2015

Initiative 4 Sustainable Living CBO was successfully founded by Mr. Herbert Tigateege with support of 30 members from Iganga district community.

Ground work was initiated and fortunately I4SL got its first opportunity to network and cooperate with SMU (**Saemaul Undong Programme**) administered Embassy of South Korea in Uganda to teach and instill the spirit of **Patriotism** to the local citizens basing on the 3 Principals of **Diligence, Self-help** and **Cooperation** introduced by President **Park Chung-hee** in 1970. We promoted this Programme in different communities of Iganga for three years. It created a lot of impact and awareness and our people learnt their role and responsibility in development.

2016

We started building international collaborations and networking and as a result we hosted David L Kabasa from SAIDETN company from The Republic of Ireland at Iganga and discussed a possible partnership to establish RABBIN (**Rural Area Broad Band Internet Work**).

In the same year, we also hosted The President of **Anointed Community Services International** from Florida US. During her visit we successfully ran the following activities;

- We visited and identified several Orphans and Vulnerable Children who needed support .
- We visited and interacted with several women living with **HIV/AIDS** and promised to empower them with support to help them improve their house hold income.
- We conducted several conferences with university students in **Jinja and Kamuli** and promised to help them identify sponsors who could support the poor with tuition for their education.
- We conducted meetings with pastors and encouraged to lead with diligence

We networked with **Busoga Kingdom** to support and promote talents of the youth especially p

performing artists and we started a platform entitled **Busoga Artists Network** which helped many thrive and produce quality music, please view the Facebook page.

We introduced farmers to modern farming techniques with help and support of our American friends living in Uganda. Many of them got an opportunity to visit their **demonstration farm** located in Mayuge.

With support and cooperation of **Work for A Living Programm** several young professionals got an opportunity to train on how to apply for a job and write CV which helped many people to get jobs after wards hence

2017

We networked with a Ugandan based American Community Based Organization called **SOLE HOPE** and conducted series **Free Medical Camps** that helped treat hundreds of people suffering from **Jiggers**, some were referred to the medical facility in Jinja for advanced treatment.

We networked and collaborated with the office of the Mayor Iganga Municipal Council to build international collaborations for social economic development partners which enable us to coordinate with Dr. Michael Hardin from Pennsylvania to establish a Christian E- library in Iganga and got the opportunity to host him in Uganda and trained about 600 clergy in financial literacy and ministry.

2018

We took a delegation of 10 attended and physically in the DLD Digital conference in Tel Aviv in Israel which created a lot of exposure to our people.

2019

We sent 2 delegates to participate and present in a global conference hosted by 1 Million Start ups in Vienna in Austria and several doors opened and Herbert Igatege was appointed to be the Curator for Uganda since then to date.

2020

Collaborated and networked with Vienna Hub online Platform led by our mentor Nigel Stoneham to promote African initiatives to the people of Vienna digitally.

2021

We collaborated with Chevening Alumni Association Uganda to give career guidance to Uganda professional fraternity with the first degrees but wish to obtain scholarships for Masters Degrees in UK universities, The programme runs annually
